



Cutout Dimensions

30" (762mm)	24 12/16" (628mm)	7 2/3" (195mm)	To ensure safety there must be separate holes for electrical and gas supply.

Note: The dimension B (628 mm) is slightly larger than the depth till the front Rangetop bezel (625 mm) to hide the meeting point of the two surfaces within the furniture.
